

Our explorers had a blast at Sydney Zoo, encountering cuddly koalas and cheeky chimpanzees. Learning has never been so wild!


Emersed in Koomurri heritage, our kids, danced, sang and learned about unity and diversity. They returned home with a colourful boomerang!

Science is all about experiments and having fun! Students participated in a practical excursion about forces.




SPORT

Athletics is the focus this term with the athletics carnival only a few weeks away. Students are gaining new skills in relay, discus, and shotput.



Students in Years 3 and 4 have been reading Arabic words from Quranic script.


I pray that all those who have embarked on the blessed journey of Hajj return back safely to their loved ones. Eid Mubarak and happy holidays to our Arkana College family.
