Thank you for entrusting me with your little one, We'll keep having fun, until the year is done!


























We are so excited to have met you all,

Bismillah, let's begin and make this a year not to forget!



We are learning how to tell the time in different ways. First step is to understand the different parts of a clock and what they mean. Time to make our own clocks.




BRAIN BREAKS

YEAR 3&4 CONTINUE THEIR HARD WORK IN DEVELOPING THEIR ARABIC QURANIC READING.


